COURSE DESCRIPTION

The course will consolidate knowledge of Latin grammar and the basic mechanisms of translation.

OBJECTIVES

Students will develop skills in reading, comprehension and translation of a Latin text, as well as skills in grammar and conjugation with a command of the complex sentence, verbal modes and Latin syntax. The sessions include work on Latin vocabulary, etymology and the realia of Roman civilisation.
