COURSE DESCRIPTION

This French language course focuses on the 4 main skills: listening, speaking, reading and writing as well as grammar and vocab practice from A1 to B2 levels.

Fall semester courses are not repeated during the Spring semester. This means that the Spring semester represents a + level, i.e. a B2 level during the Fall semester is followed by a B2+ level during the Spring semester. Students who arrive for the Spring semester only may have to work harder to catch up.

OBJECTIVES

Through a variety of topics selected by the teacher, students will improve their knowledge not only in terms of language for daily communication but also in terms of culture (social interactions, cultural behaviour, implicit..).

PREREQUISITES

Students must take a placement test at the beginning of the semester to determine their language skill level. Please note that this course is subject to a minimum of 8 participants per level.
