Prepare for your arrival at the University of Angers

- Request an invitation letter if necessary
- Send your Learning Agreement once approved by your university's academic coordinator
- Enquire about exchange students at UA

Make sure you bring originals and/or copies of:

- Your I.D. card and/or passport
- Your health insurance card or health insurance policy
- Your vaccinations
- Your passport photographs
- Your birth certificate

After you arrive in Angers

Settling in at the university halls of residence

If you are not staying at a residence hall, go to the next step. Residences are open 24/7.



- Go to the reception desk of the residence and ask for your keys to settle into your room
- Fill in your occupancy form
- Pay for the first month's rent and deposit (ISEP students only have to pay for the deposit)
- Pay for the bedding pack (€27.26 for 1 disposable quilt, 1 disposable pillow, 2 sheets, 1 pillowcase). If you do not want to buy it, please inform the residence upon arrival
- Carry out an inventory check

Registering with the International Office

- Go to the Incoming Student Office on 2 rue Lakanal for registration
- Get your Arrival Certificate signed – if applicable
- Submit your Learning Agreement – if you haven't sent it yet
- Get your Welcome Pack
- If you haven't paid online for your residence's reservation fees (€50), you can pay in cash at our office
- If you haven't paid online for your housing insurance fees (€27), you can pay at the SMEBA agency (46 Bd du Roi René, Angers)

Registering with your department

- European students: provide a copy of your European Health Insurance Card and a copy of your I.D. card or passport
- Non-European students: provide a copy of your passport
- Get your student card
- Get your enrolment certificate



AFTER ENROLLING YOU CAN :

- **Log in to your intranet account (ENT)**
- **Eat at the university restaurant (RU)**
- **Play sports (SUAPS)**
- **Borrow books from the university library (BU)**



If you arrive on a Sunday

Sundays are legal rest days and only a few shops are open.
