## **EDITORIAL**

Research at the University of Angers is as dense as its multidisciplinary nature. The 26 research units are divided into 5 research departments (Plant & environmental sciences; Medical sciences; Materials sciences; Mathematics and computer sciences; Humanities, languages and social sciences) each led by a Federative Structure (SFR). SFRs are key elements for stimulating inter-disciplinarity as a source of added value, and for highlighting strong research themes representing fields of excellence as well as promising emerging research areas. These SFRs also assume the management of technological and shared resources such as platforms or technical facilities.

To support all scientists, **the Department of Research**, **Innovation and Doctoral Schools** (Dried) offers a variety of services.

#### RESEARCH DEPARTMENT

The research department prepares the institution's research commission and then implements its decisions.

Its main missions are to:

- implement research policy (structuring, organisation and funding),
- coordinate the assessments of research structures and doctoral schools,
- monitor institutional partnerships,
- establish indicators of scientific activity,
- coordinate transversal working groups (international, communication, financial and legal monitoring, etc.),
- implement the open science policy.

### PARTNERSHIP AND INNOVATION DEPARTMENT

External sources of research funding take the form of calls for proposals and collaborative research programs. In this context, the missions of the Partnership and Innovation department aim to:

- support teacher researchers in their efforts to identify, set up and monitor regional, national and international projects in collaboration with the CAP Europe unit,
- ensure relations with funding partners and the socio-economic world in collaboration with the recovery operator (SATT Ouest Valorisation, etc.),
- helping to define the economic and cultural valorization strategy (patents, confidentiality agreements, scientific popularisation, etc.).









#### DOCTORAL DEPARTMENT

The doctoral studies department is the referent service for doctoral training at the University of Angers. It supports the activities of the 10 thematic doctoral schools of the regional doctoral college. Its main missions are to:

- inform doctoral candidates,
- manage the schooling of doctoral students,
- coordinate the organisation of cross-disciplinary training and professional integration assistance for PhD students,
- ensure the organisation of and the participation in doctoral related events,
- support the initiatives of PhD student associations.

#### FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT

The missions of this department are:

- the completion and monitoring of expenses in accordance with the research agreements and the procurement policy of the institution,
- preparation of expenses supporting documents, local budgetary management with the research structures and the research department.
