Description of the research project in which the research activities entrusted to the officer take place:

The Observatoire départemental de la protection de l'enfance de Maine-et-Loire, and in particular its Comité Etudes, recherches et prospective, would like to carry out a study of the impact of the child prevention and protection policy on the development of parenting skills in relation to children's needs. The study will form part of the 2023-2027 departmental plan for children and families. The study will enable players in the sector to gain an insight into the impact of their actions and systems. The study will be conducted within the framework of the CLiPsy Laboratory.

Provisional project schedule:

December 2024-February 2025: state of the art and current situation, preparation of field survey with partners

March 2025-July 2025: recruitment of cohorts (unaccompanied parents, parents accompanied in prevention, parents accompanied in protection), administration of standardized tool (target: 100), interviews with parents concerned (target: 20)

September-December: data analysis, results, written report.

Definition of research activities and tasks to be accomplished:

- Draw up a state-of-the-art report on prevention, social and educational assistance and, more generally, support for parents;
- Draw up an inventory of the services available in the region to support people in their parental role, and their evolution over time;
- Establish a typology of parents' resources and needs by conducting and analyzing quantitative and qualitative surveys, integrating the methodology for measuring the social impact of actions on the people concerned;

Expected skills :

Knowledge :

- psychological, social and cultural knowledge of childhood and the family
- Knowledge of the institutions involved, and of child prevention and protection systems.

Know-how:

- Set up a survey methodology in conjunction with several partners
- Conduct semi-structured interviews
- Analyze quantitative and qualitative data
- Write an accurate report of results

Soft skills:

- Respect for all partners and their operating methods
- Discretion and efficiency in research
- Ethics towards families (children and parents)
