CERTIFICATE IN FRENCH STUDIES

This **diploma** programme is aimed at non-native French speakers who would like to perfect their French and who hold at least a high-school diploma.

- Levels: from A1 to C1.
- Goals: achieve proficiency in written and spoken French, discover French culture, prepare for a successful transition to university.
- 2 sessions per year: from September to January and from February to June.
- 204 contact hours per session.
- Courses offered:
 - Language classes
 - Oral production
 - Written production
 - Grammar
 - Phonetics
 - Culture
 - French for Academic Purposes starting from level B1.2
 - Specialisation (courses in a specific faculty/department based on the student's chosen discipline) from level B2+



From level B2 onwards, the DUEF also certifies the French level required for admission to the University of Angers.

FRENCH COURSES

FOR STUDENTS AND RESEARCHERS

These courses leading to a **qualification** are intended for exchange programme students, individual students and international researchers enrolled at the University of Angers.

- **French language course** from A1 to C1.
- **French conversation classes** from A2 to C1.
- **French for Academic Purposes** for B2/C1.
- **French for Medical Purposes** for exchange/freemover medical students undertaking work placements at the University Hospital of Angers.
- **Tutoring in written French** for international undergraduate students.
- **UA "How-to" induction seminar** at the start of the first semester.

CERTIFICATION EXAMS

■ DELF/DALF



These certificates are internationally recognised and often used by foreign departments of education worldwide.

The DELF and the DALF certify the level of proficiency in the four language skills and are valid for life.

The following exams can be taken at the CeLFE every year:

DELFB1 and B2 - Diplôme d'Études en Langue Française

DALF C1 and C2 - Diplôme approfondi de Langue Française

■ TCF



The **TCF-TP** ("Test de Connaissance du Français - Tout Public") is a language proficiency test designed to assess French skills for personal, academic or professional reasons.

The **TCF-DAP** ("Test de Connaissance du Français pour la Demande d'Admission Préalable") is useful for applying to undergraduate university studies or school of architecture in France.

TCF test results are valid for 2 years.

Every year over **500 international students and candidates** choose the CelFE.



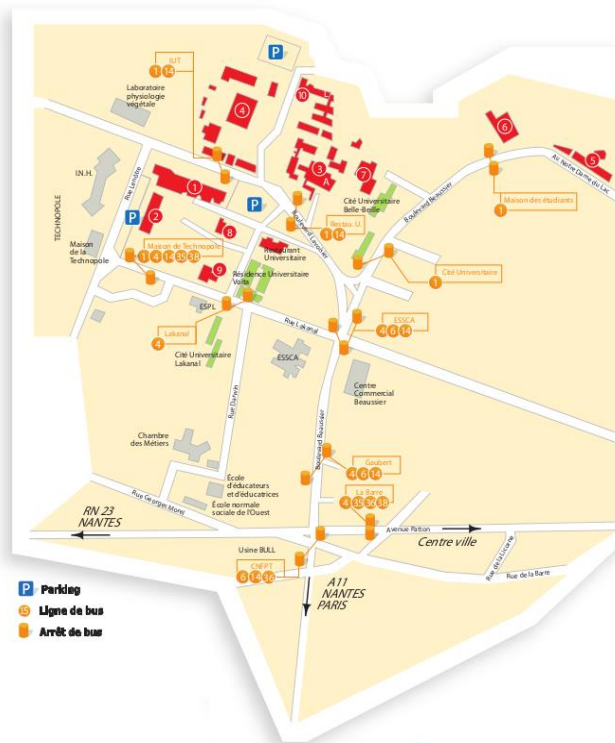
