## COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course will give students knowledge about cultural fundamentals and vocabulary in France.  
Key competencies: how to greet people, how to introduce oneself, basic shopping to get some food, physical appearance and clothes, accommodation and lodging, the weather, the seasons, time and date, how to get to know people, to tell about one's family.

Course attendance counts 50 % of the final assessment.

A final exam in face-to-face with the teacher also counts 50 %.

During this final exam, students must know how to introduce themselves in French for ten minutes, give as much information as they can about their likes and dislikes, families, place of studies, life in France, the flat they live in.

## OBJECTIVES

Students will acquire linguistic autonomy to make life in France easier; see a doctor, take public transportation, go shopping, and socialise with other people.

A minimum level is required: at least A1. Students should master the basics of French: to introduce themselves and say hello. Regular homework is important to make progress.
