COURSE DESCRIPTION

The first part of the course will briefly present the history of linguistic ideas since Saussure, shedding light on the main concepts frequently reused in language teaching and the possible distortions related to their use in didactics, and relating this evolution to that of FFL (French as a foreign language) teaching/learning methodologies.

The second part will focus on the study of a number of areas of language science, in order to deepen the essential concepts and show their application in FFL didactics, for example, in syntax, the principles and methods of distributional analysis and immediate constituent analysis, and, in discourse linguistics, an introduction to enunciation, the notions of dialogism and polyphony, textual heterogeneity, etc.
