## COURSE DESCRIPTION

Students will 1) take an overview of students' (learners or trainers) experiences with digital technology in language teaching, 2) reflect on common practices, their advantages and limitations, 3) learn about the institutional and legal framework, 3) discover the technical aspects to take into account, 4) learn how to draw conclusions on the criteria for choosing which tools to use and explore tools that meet these criteria, 5) get hands-on experience using each of these tools, 6) reflect on the advantages and shortcomings of each tool, 7) define a pedagogical project: framework, objectives, etc. and determine the relevant tools that can help implement this project, 8) create and publish a coherent and functional digital platform based on these tools
