COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course focuses on grammar in language teaching and learning. Students will 1) review the history of grammar teaching through the history of methodologies, 2) learn the concepts associated with different methodologies, acquire the linguistic tools and concepts to build FFL (French as a foreign language) courses, 3) analyse the grammatical fact in FFL, FLM textbooks, 4) Integrate grammar into an FFL course- become familiar with the typology of grammatical exercises, 5) design pedagogical sequences
